We are on the road to exceeding our goal this year. Thanks to all who have supported the raffle and our Scottish Arts Scholarships.


You can still buy more tickets or turn in your raffle tickets:


- Friday at the Ceilidh...we have a table and roving sellers (Dick Fromm, again)

Off the Shelf... News about the Charles S. Low Memorial Library

Update: The Library is going thru a major inventory project and is approximately 75% complete. This project will ensure that books are in the right location on the shelves, that spine labels and book plates are correct and placed on the books, that the database is correct and finally we are pulling duplicate books from the shelves. During the month of August and September the staff will be updating the Library's Operation Document with policies for accepting books, material and artifacts.

A major effort has taken place prior to and at the Highland Games to expand the number of Clans that are participating with the Library. The Clan Collection will benefit from the donation of books, material and artifacts being donated by the Clans. This material will be on display in the Library to assist members and those wanting to research their family history.

On November 2nd, the Low Library along with the Friends of the Troy Library will be hosting a Game of Thrones night to help raise funds for the operation of both Libraries. This will also allow members of the community to come and see our building and possibly join the Society


